RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE VILLAS OF INDIGO RUN AT BEAR CREEK

These rules and regulations are authorized by section 11 of the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, Easements and Restrictions of the Villas of Indigo Run at Bear Creek and are as follows:

- 1. No statues or other ornamentals of any kind are permitted to be in any yard or common area of the development.
- 2. No electric fences are to exist unless the Board of Directors has reviewed the plans before its installation and approves such fencing.
- 3. All exterior Christmas decorations are not permitted to be displayed before November $15^{\rm th}$ of each year and must be removed by January $15^{\rm th}$ of the next year.
- 4. All satellite dishes or other receiving appliances are to be at a location and pursuant to a submitted plan that has been previously approved by the Board of Directors.
- 5. All rear exterior landscaping must have a plan that is submitted to and approved by the Board of Directors. After such approval and installation of landscaping, all landscaping is to be property maintained and if not maintained, then upon request by the Board of Directors, is to be removed. If the landscaping is not removed within fifteen (15) days of such request, then the Board of Directors may remove such landscaping and all costs as if those costs were an assessment.


