If you have not taken advantage of our homeowner holiday discounted gift card promo, there is still time to do it. Cards can be bought until January 31st. There are 4 levels of savings exclusively for Bear Creek homeowners.

Carts will be equipped with 10 inch monitors. There are several benefits for golfers, from Hole Overviews, Pin placement, distance measurements, & blind shot directions. From an operational standpoint we will be able to track golfers on course, restrict cart traffic, communicate with golfers via messaging, handle pace of play issues directly, & better manage our cart fleet. We are very excited about the added benefit this brings to playing a round at Bear Creek.

Many homeowners have used our clubhouse for baby & wedding showers as well as other social events. We completed some updates on our lower level 19th hole early last year and believe this area is the perfect place for those type events. Subdivision Updates from David Lewis

Swimming Pool:

Over the past few years we have invested a good amount of money into the community pool to try to maintain the quality of the offering. During this spring the trustees are evaluating additional repairs and maintenance items identified by our pool management company. Once bids are in after the first of the year we will evaluate what we can afford and what the priorities are.

One of the things we are getting pricing on is whether to switch from the annual laminated cards to an electronic access control system that would allow us to provide dongles to the homeowners for use to access the pool.

Reminder with all the hail damage work, the contractor signs can only be up for a limited time. Please take them down and dispose of them in a timely manner.

Trash cans must not be left outside other than for the pickup date. Notices will and are being sent out to provide a reminder. Repeat offenders run the risk of getting fines levied.
